A third generation painter, author, and illustrator, N. Cameron Watson credits much of her early artistic training to both her family and intensive self study. After completing a three-year apprenticeship in Germany and graduating *cum laude* from Yale College where she studied drawing, color theory, philosophy and sculpture, Watson expanded her interests and talents, and began receiving numerous awards for her work.

In 2007, her work was featured on WCVB TV's evening news magazine *Chronicle*, and in 2008, it was displayed in a solo show at the Cape Cod Museum of Art. Watson's work has also been featured in shows at the Cape Cod Museum of Art and the Provincetown Art Association & Museum, and can be found in various private collections.
